

Factors to be considered in designing a community involvement in MRV

- Land tenure and management rights on forests of local communities
 - Definition of local communities
 - Proportion of (forest) land under management of local communities: Indonesia <5%, Vietnam: 20%, Mexico: 58%
 - Delineation of forests under mgt of local communities
 - Institutional arrangements in place for community monitoring
 - Protocols available?
 - Policy instruments to be used under REDD+

- How local communities could be involved in the forest monitoring processes? Which activities?
- Dependent upon existing institutional system/arrangement

MRV structure (to be decided)

- Linkages between PFM and National monitoring system
 - Direct to central (national) agency or
 - Through intermediate levels?

It is dependent upon the legitimate and political structure in the country, and costs

- Baseline(s)
 - National baseline for international reporting
 - Internal/domestic baselines, which is decided by relevant stakeholders, taking into account of local circumstances
- Reward system: should be discussed first and influences the monitoring system
