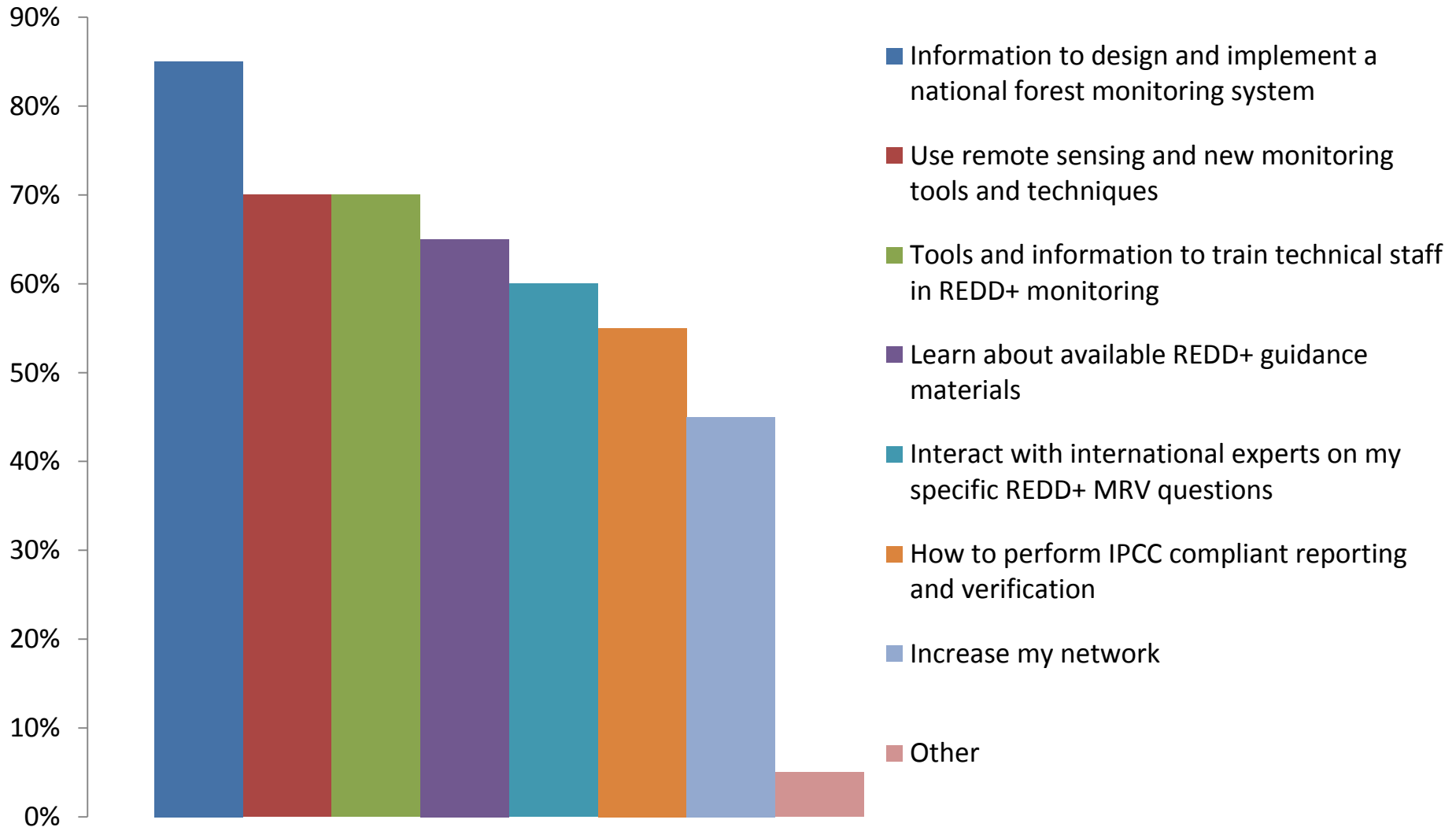
Workshop background

- Training the trainers

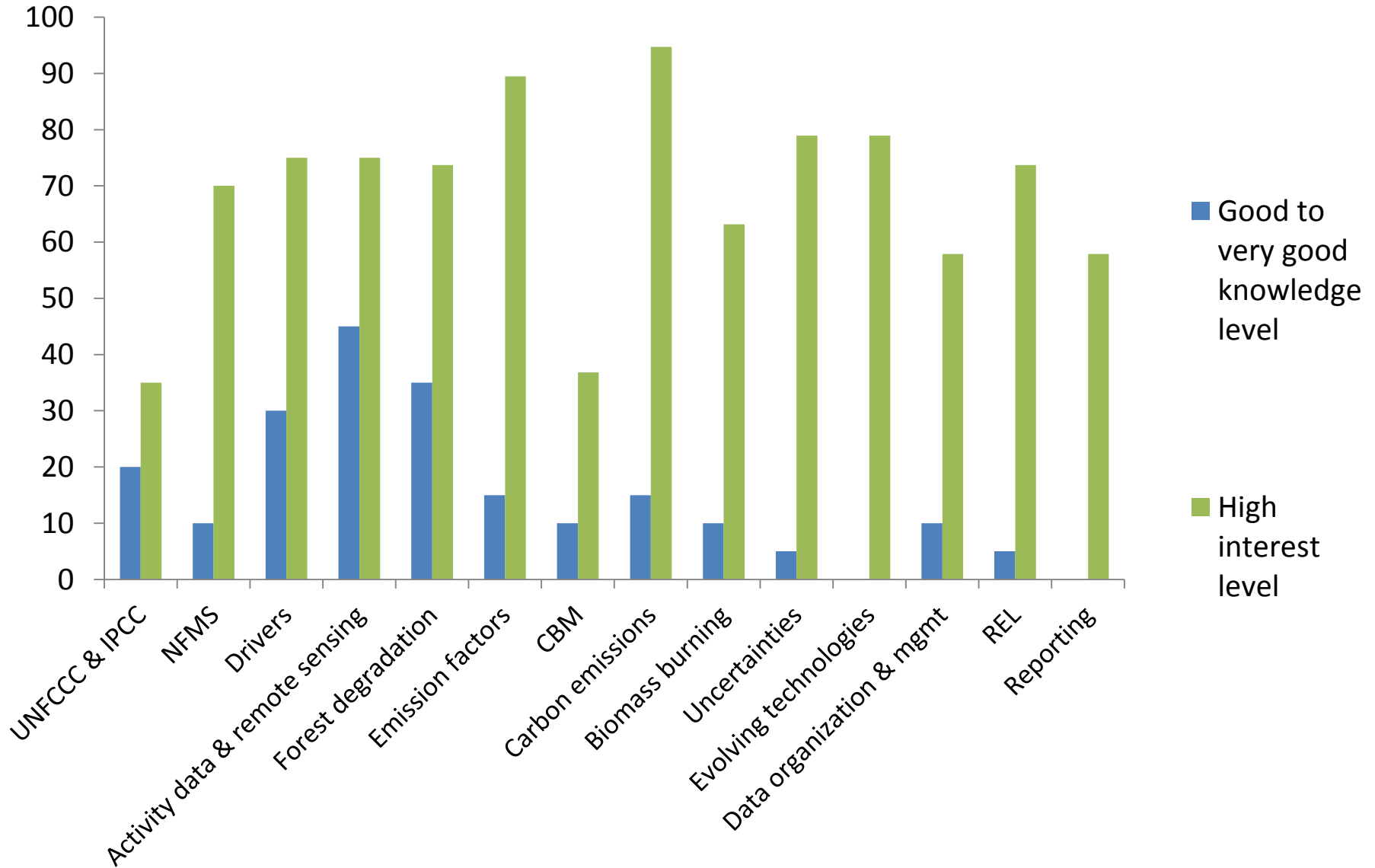
